

One of the ongoing projects of FCI is the distribution of educational materials to lower income schools and teachers in remote areas of Indonesia. FCI has translated into Indonesian the **STEPS character building curriculum set**. (Perangkat Program LANGKAH Tumbuh Kembang Pembentukan Karakter) This set includes 20 course subjects, with a booklet on each one featuring stories, illustrations, and activities, a teacher's handbook with active learning activities, just-for-fun games, and a sing-along CD and an award certificate is included with each set. Through sponsorship for these sets FCI volunteers distribute them for free in remote areas.

A FCI team donated a set of STEPS to Teratai Jaya orphanage while in **Jambi, Sumatera** this past month.

Distribution of Multivitamins (Scott's Emulsion) throughout Indonesia

They visited many primary schools, preschools and cooperated with other organizations to distribute the vitamins in remote areas. They also provided some of the preschools (PAUD groups) with the STEPS character building curriculum set. We would like to thank and acknowledge those who help to make this project possible.
